1. This space is for self-identified Indigenous students in the Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences. To access the space, please reach out to the Indigenous Strategic Initiatives (ISI) Manager to confirm your access and have your student ID programmed.
2. To maintain a safe and confidential environment, we kindly ask that guests not be invited. Faculty and non-Indigenous students may join approved cultural teaching sessions as invited guests.
3. Quiet hours are weekdays from 7–9 am and 5–7 pm for silent study.
4. To book the space for learning or cultural events, please contact the ISI Manager at least one week in advance and check the calendar to avoid conflicts with Indigenous Pharmacy Student Collegium (IPSC) meetings or cultural activities.
5. Before any photography or filming, please check in with the ISI Manager. This should only happen during open gatherings with everyone's consent or when the space is empty.
6. Eating is welcome—please tidy up after yourself. Food storage is not available.
7. Thank you for helping keep this space welcoming and safe for everyone. If these guidelines are not followed, access may be removed.
